This is in response to your 13 October 2011 Freedom of Information Act (FOIA) request received at AFPC/DS1F on 24 October 2011. Your request (AFPC Case # 2012-00339-F) seeks:

1. **All data regarding subject "legal precedent" from JAG Office, including current position/or how to proceed with legal precedent claims. To include electronic messages, documents on subject, intent, briefings, messages from USAF Secretary legal precedent.**
2. **All power point presentations on the subject matter of "legal precedent" and position of JAG Office on subject of legal precedent.**
3. **JAG Office overseeing AFBCMR documents concerning stare decisis.**
4. **Documents showing binding authority on court decisions and procedures for USAF personnel to follow when courts render decisions effecting BCMR's. Including messages sent to BCMR personnel by JAG Office Personnel on dealing with binding authority and court decisions.**

The AFPC does not maintain AFBCMR electronic messages, files, or briefings. The responsive documents may be under control of SAF/MRBR. Only currently servicing members of the AF Board for Correction of Military Records (AFBCMR) may access AFBCMR case files.

You may submit a FOIA request electronically at the following web-link: <https://www.foia.af.mil/palMain.aspx> or mail your request to HAF/IMII (FOIA), 1000 Air Force, Pentagon, Washington D.C. 20330-1000. They will reply directly to you.

If you interpret this "no records" response as an adverse action, you may appeal this decision by writing to the Secretary of the Air Force within 60 calendar days from date of this letter. If no appeal is received, or if appeal is postmarked after conclusion of this 60-day period, the appeal may be considered closed. Include your reasons for reconsideration along with a copy of this letter. Mail to:
